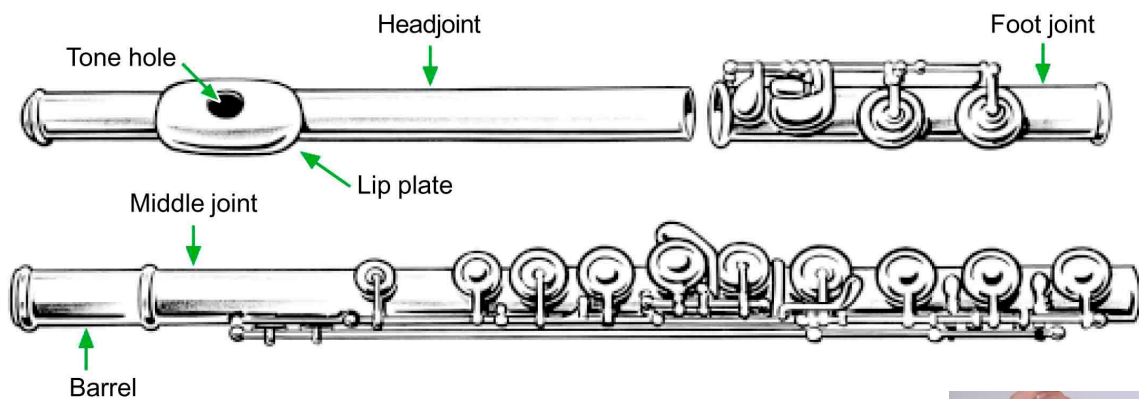
SETUP AND CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for your purchase of a quality AXIOM Flute. If properly cared for this flute will provide you with years of playing pleasure. Please take a moment to read these important notes regarding your flute. Our 2 Year Warranty does not cover damage caused by incorrect handling or usage.

ASSEMBLING YOUR FLUTE

Before assembling your new flute remove the packing wedges from the keys using tweezers or similar. Be sure to remove all wedges.

When you are putting your flute together **it is very important to grip the instrument away from the keys**. The keys on a flute are very delicate and gripping tightly around the keys can result in damage to the rods and keys, causing poor pad sealing and difficulties in playing. Hold the pieces at the ends and away from the keys and gently slide together. Line up the keys so they are evenly aligned.



CARING FOR YOUR FLUTE

Your AXIOM flute requires regular cleaning and maintenance to ensure it remains in peak playing condition.

The most important thing to do is to clean and dry the insides of the flute after each time you play. Using the rod which comes with the instrument and a soft cloth carefully dry and clean the head-joint and middle joint as shown. **DO NOT HOLD THE FLUTE AROUND THE KEYS.**

Gently clean the exterior of the flute using the soft cloth provided, being careful not to damage the keys.

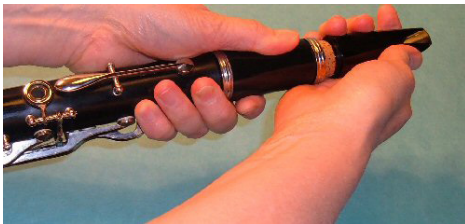

SETUP AND CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for your purchase of a quality AXIOM Clarinet. If properly cared for this clarinet will provide you with years of playing pleasure. Please take a moment to read these important notes regarding your clarinet. Our 2 Year Warranty does not cover damage caused by incorrect handling or usage.

Parts of the Clarinet

ASSEMBLING YOUR CLARINET

Before assembling your new clarinet remove the packing wedges from the keys using tweezers or similar. Be sure to remove all wedges.

When you are putting your clarinet together **it is very important to grip the instrument away from the keys**. The keys on a clarinet are very delicate and gripping tightly around the keys can result in damage to the rods and keys, causing poor pad sealing and difficulties in playing.

Apply a small amount of Cork Grease to the cork joints on each section. Do not over use. Hold the pieces **at the ends** and away from the keys and firmly slide together, twisting the sections as you do so.

Make sure the Bridge section slides over the opposing piece. (See picture)

Do not force the pieces together. Use a firm but gentle twisting motion.

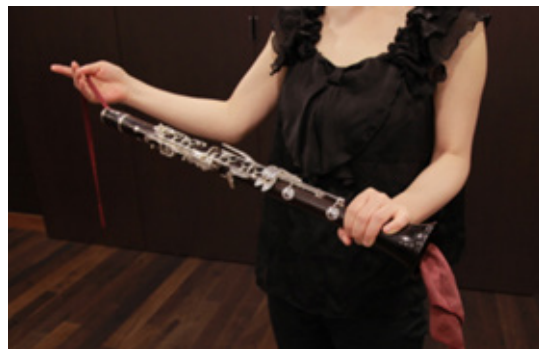
CARING FOR YOUR CLARINET

Your AXIOM clarinet requires regular cleaning and maintenance to ensure it remains in peak playing condition.

The most important thing to do is to clean and dry the insides of the clarinet after each time you play. Using the clarinet pull-through swab carefully dry and clean the instrument as shown. **DO NOT HOLD THE CLARINET AROUND THE KEYS.**

Gently clean the exterior of the clarinet using the soft cloth provided, being careful not to damage the keys.
